as of June 2017



Sweet Auburn has seen over \$155 million in investment over the past two years. Another \$514 million is under construction or planned to be completed by 2020 for a total of \$689 million which includes 4,021 residential units & student beds, 4,300 sf retail and office space, and 532,500 sf institutional space.


